ADULT & YOUTH (AGES 10+) JAZZ COMBO: \$200 BEFORE 7/31, \$225 AFTER 7/31 Dates/Times dependent on availability of participants. This class will help you develop skills necessary to perform in a small jazz ensemble setting, with focus on learning new repertoire and the essential elements of improvisation. Tuition includes 10 60' classes.

ADVANCED PIANO ACADEMY: \$85 BEFORE 7/31, \$95 AFTER 7/31 for monthly 60' classes during the entire school year (August 2015 through May 2016) and frequent masterclasses with guest artists. Students have the opportunity to discover their full potential in the most comprehensive, engaging and rigorous programming available - and they'll have fun doing it!
