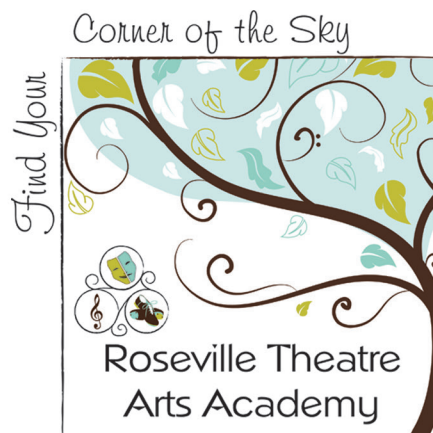
The shows in our exciting Field Trip Series are well-suited for children in Pre-Kindergarten through Fifth Grade and for children's groups that include children ages 4 through 11.

- Advanced reservations are required.
- Tickets for Field Trip performances are \$6 for students and chaperones. One teacher per class may attend at no charge.
- Final ticket counts are required on the Monday prior to the selected performance.
- A non-refundable \$50 deposit is required for each school group. The deposit will be deducted from the total ticket fees, with the balance due at the door on the day of the event.
- Walk-ins are not able to be accommodated on the day of the show.
- Seating for all performances is by grade level. Every attempt will be made to seat schools together; however, due to varying class sizes, some schools may be seated in separate sections.
- Please inquire about deposit rates for groups of fewer than 30 children.
- Performances are approximately one hour.

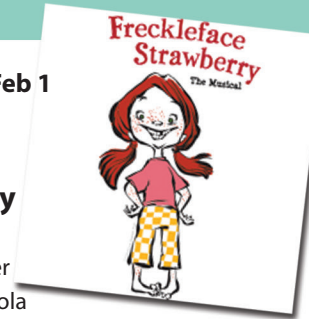
