EVOLUTION OF THE TRANSEPT: GERMAN GOTHIC CHURCH TO ELEGANT EVENT SPACE

Cincinnati, OH,— Rich Cincinnati history is being preserved in the renovation of the German gothic church on the corner of Washington Park in Over-The-Rhine. Within the walls of the old church, the Transept evolves. The Transept, Cincinnati's newest event facility, offers sophisticated spaces for weddings, meetings, receptions and social gatherings.

This fully renovated space transformed St. Johns Evangelical Protestant Church, originally built in 1886, into a unique space for events and meetings. The \$4.7 million renovation includes 50 foot ceilings, a fully restored bell tower, stained glass windows and over 13,000 square feet of space. The innovative event space combines ornate design and historic preservation, with a reinvented purpose in order to offer unbelievable experiences to its future guests. The venue also



offers a private bridal suite, tucked away in the church's bell tower, as well as The Vestry, the inhouse bar open to the public.
