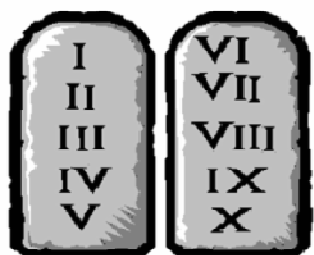

What is a Ten Commandments Hike?

A unique and exciting way to embrace the concept of religious tolerance, learn local history, participate in community service, and have fun. We will leisurely hike as a group to several places of worship in downtown Augusta to learn about the Commandments. At each stop, for approximately 15 to 20 minutes, a representative of the place of Worship will discuss one or two of the 10 Commandments; introduce the basic theological tenets of their faith, and point out interesting architectural and historical aspects of their House of Worship.

When: Saturday, April 16th, start at 9:00 am sharp, check in 8:00- 8:45 am.

Who: All Scouts (for Cubs, suggested Wolf rank and up).

Registration: Online via the council calendar until April 10, 2016 .

Cost: \$5 preregistration, \$8 walk up registration.

Dress: Class A Uniform

Check-in: Patches and wrist bands given to Unit leader

Required: BSA Medical forms, check in as unit including minimum two leaders

Where: Downtown Augusta, GA. Park at check-in church assigned to district:

- Creek River **First Presbyterian** on Telfair St.
- Kiokee River **Most Holy Trinity Catholic Church** on Telfair St.
- Yamasee **Lutheran Church of the Resurrection** on Greene St.

The other destinations on the walk are **St. John United Methodist**, **Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox** and the **Woodrow Wilson House**.

Note: Event expected to last about four hours. A water will be provided. Be prepared in case of cold or rainy weather. All Cub Scouts are required to have a parent, guardian, Pack leader or Den leader in attendance.

Scouts 15 and older may volunteer for Safety Patrol. Volunteers will be required to attend a planning meeting on April 14th at 7:00 PM.
