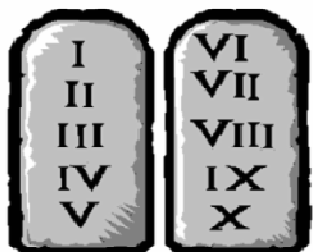

## **10 COMMANDMENTS HIKE**

### ***What is a Ten Commandments Hike?***

A unique and exciting way to embrace the concept of religious tolerance, learn local history, participate in community service, and have fun. We will leisurely hike as a group to several places of worship in downtown Augusta to learn about the Commandments. At each stop, for approximately 15 to 20 minutes, a representative of the place of Worship will discuss one or two of the 10 Commandments; introduce the basic theological tenets of their faith, and point out interesting architectural and historical aspects of their House of Worship .

**When:** Saturday, April 16th, start at 9:00 am sharp, check in at 8:00.
