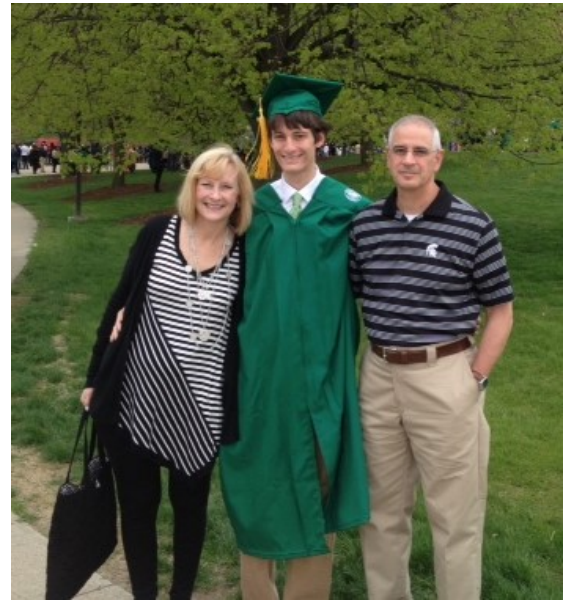


Congratulations, Graduates!

Nathan Pellerito graduated from Novi High School. He will be studying computer science at Central Michigan University next year.

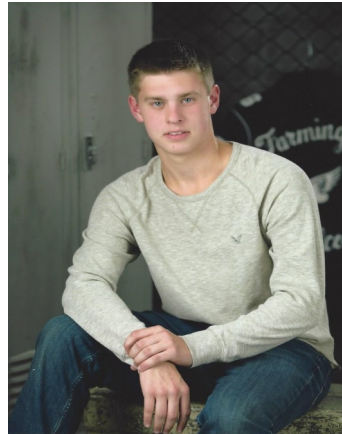
