



2015 AIA Cleveland Sand Castle Competition & Volleyball Tournament - SAND CASTLE TEAM REGISTRATION Saturday, July 18 | Edgewater Beach

AIA Cleveland is going to the beach! Dozens of teams from Cleveland's most prolific Architecture and Design Firms are hitting the beach to determine the royalty of Northeast Ohio's nascent sand castle design-build and beach volleyball industries. All firm personnel, loved ones, and friends are welcome at this family-friendly event, hosted by Cleveland Metroparks. Individuals and firms are welcome to enter multiple teams, but all teams must pre-register and one registration form must be filled out for FOR EACH TEAM.

NOTE: Deadline for Sand Castle Team Registration is MONDAY, JULY 6.

Competition Rules:

- 1. Participation fee is \$150 per team and must be paid upon registration.
- Scholarships will be awarded to the top three finishers: Grand Prize (\$600), Second Place (\$450), and Third Place (\$300), determined by a celebrity jury on the basis of concept, innovation, and execution.
- 3. Teams of all abilities are welcome and all reasonable accommodations will be made to make sure everyone has a good time.
- 4. Provisions:
 - Each team will be provided a 20' x 20' plot, with at least 2 cubic yards of clean building sand, self-selected by the teams upon arrival.
 - Two pumping locations (lake water) will be near the competition area.
 - Drinking water (free) and concessions (cash) will be available to competitors throughout the day.
- 5. Teams are responsible for providing all of their own tools/implements.
- 6. All team activities and tools must remain inside the team's plot.
- No foreign substances or building materials of any kind are allowed in the construction of the castle; the only non-sand materials that are allowed are those objects found on the beach.
- 8. Shading devices (tarps, shade tents, etc.) are highly recommended, but must be removed prior to judging.
- 9. No vehicles are allowed beyond designated Edgewater parking areas.
- 10. A team representative must attend a pre-build meeting on July 9.
- 11. Roster size is not limited, but members may not participate on more than one team. Up to eight team members will be formally recognized.
- 12. AIA Cleveland plans to assign three interested high school students from the ACE mentoring program to each registered team. Those students should be fully engaged in the design/build process.
- 13. The competition will be overseen by a committee of volunteers who will not tolerate abusive language or behavior. Offending participants will be issued a warning and then disqualified from the competition with a second violation of this rule. Particularly egregious or harmful behavior will result in the immediate disqualification of the competitor and his/her team without warning.
- 14. Any appeals should be formally lodged with the competition committee, who will make a swift decision. All decisions are final.
- 15. All participants are required to sign a waiver, releasing AIA Cleveland from any liability associated with their engagement in the competition.
