Course news with Carey Spence!

The golf course is in good condition. The thin areas of turf on the fairways are beginning to fill in with the warmer temperatures. The greens, tee boxes, and the green surrounds are in very good condition. However, unrepaired ball marks on the greens continue to be a problem.

Cultural practices to assist the base Bermuda turf grass will begin to be implemented in late April early May. These practices will cause the over seed winter grass to begin to thin out and allow for a healthy Bermuda grass transition.

Sand will be added in a few bunkers where needed in the near future.

An aerification is scheduled for the first week of May on the greens. Notices will be posted in the golf shop once the date has been finalized.

NUMBERS NEVER* LIE

Do you keep statistics of your rounds? Some stats to keep are fairways hit, greens in regulation, sand saves, putts taken, up and downs completed. These numbers do not lie, and tell the story of your strengths and weaknesses. Knowing what parts of your game require the most improvement will certainly lead to better practice sessions as well as quicker skill improvement. These stats provide clarity in helping you see what needs the most improvement in your game. People that are not professional golfers are usually pressed for time so knowing what to hone in on to improve your problem areas is key to help lower your score.
