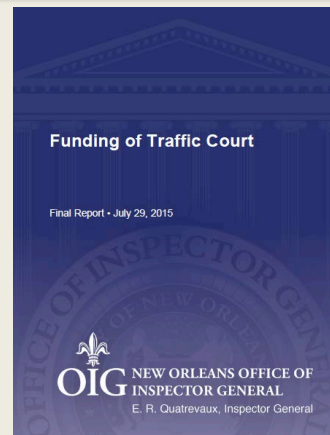


BUDGETARY CONTROL OF TRAFFIC COURT RETURNED TO CITY AS RECOMMENDED IN OIG REPORT

An OIG report on [Funding of Traffic Court](#) released July 29 recommended returning budgetary oversight of the Court to the City Council and shifting core funding to the City's general fund to reduce the Court's reliance on its Judicial Expense Fund. This recommended change was implemented when the City included the Court's funding in its 2016 operating budget.



OIG evaluators also found the Court did not collect data needed to measure performance to document efficiency, demonstrate accountability, or weigh if the Court was appropriately funded or staffed.
