

Submission Requirements:

Art in the Garden features two- and three-dimensional work in all media. Subject matter is not limited to garden-related themes.

- Artists may submit up to three works for consideration
- Work must be original and created in the past 2 years and not under instruction
- 2D art must be framed unless gallery wrapped and must include a hanging wire
- 2D entries are limited to 42" maximum in any dimension, including the frame
- 3D entries must weigh less than 50 pounds and must not require special installation
- Accepted work must be available for sale and exhibition.

Suitable substitutions may be made at the sole discretion of AIG organizers

Digital images

- All entries must be in .jpg format and mailed/delivered on a CD or uploaded to:
<http://tinyurl.com/AITG2015>
- Image dimensions should be 1200 pixels minimum and 1800 pixels maximum
- File name should include the artist's last name and first initial as well as a corresponding entry number on the entry form (ex: Smith. A1, Smith.A2)
- Submitted images should show the artwork only. Refrain from including mats, frames, easels, and background of any kind
- Jewelry images may show multiple pieces in one image

Entry Fee

\$40 for up to three entries

ART IN THE GARDEN

The Fort Worth Botanical Society and the Fort Worth Garden Club invite regional artists and artisans to submit work for the **8th Annual Art in the Garden**. As a part of Fort Worth's popular Fall Gallery Night, the juried exhibition and sale showcase artwork at the historic Fort Worth Botanic Garden in the heart of the Cultural District. Art in the Garden is a natural complement to the Fort Worth Botanic Garden and net proceeds support improvements and maintenance of the Garden.

The Fort Worth Botanic Garden was established in 1934 and is the oldest botanic garden in Texas. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, it is home to over 2,500 species of native and exotic plants in more than twenty-three specialty gardens. Just west of downtown Fort Worth and in the Cultural District, the Fort Worth Botanic Garden is a family-friendly venue.

The exhibition is open from 1:00 pm Friday, Sept. 11, 2015 to 4:00 pm Sun., Sept. 13. Gallery Night Artist's Reception is on Saturday, September 12, from 4:00-6:00pm.

Winners will be selected in seven categories, including oil/acrylic, water media, drawing/pastel, mixed media, photography, sculpture and jewelry.
