### MIHS COLLEGE COUNSELING SERVICES

MIHS serves 1500 students with a senior class of approximately 400 seniors. We usually have 86-92% of our students attend a four year college. Our four alphabetical counselors work with about 20 seniors each, walking them through the college admission process and writing their letters of recommendation for private colleges. Mj serves the remaining seniors, writing 140-180 letters of recommendation per year. For the graduating class of 2015 the counseling department processed documents for 2500 college applications. The following services make up the college counseling program at MIHS.

- College lecture series, available to all MIHS students and parents (see above)
- Individual, one hour college appointment for juniors/seniors and parent(s)
- Weekly bulk emails to students and parents, beginning in January of junior year through high school graduation
- Multiple college/career/scholarship resources through Naviance/Family Connection
- Annual visits to grade level classes. Counselors give grade-appropriate information for post-graduate plans.
- Lunch workshops in March for juniors, dealing with application components, especially the resume and essay
- Unlimited emails, phone conversations, and personal conversations with Mrs. Hillstrom starting in the second semester of the junior year
- Facilitation of admission officers of approx. 140 colleges/universities visiting our high school per year, open to all students.
- Communication: monthly newsletters, bulletin information
