Save the Date February 6th – 15th Annual Mardi Gras Parade

The Vicksburg Main Street Program is looking for "krewes" who wish to participate in Downtown Vicksburg's 15th annual Mardi Gras Parade. All area Clubs, Churches, Organizations, Schools, Drill Teams, and Businesses are invited to take place in this community parade. The parade will be held Saturday, February 6, 2016, at 4:00 p.m. in Downtown Vicksburg.

The parade begins at Washington and Belmont streets and will travel North on Washington Street to Jackson Street. The fee is \$25 for non-profit and civic groups and \$50 for businesses. After Wednesday, January 27th, 2016 the fee is \$50 for non-profit and civic groups and \$100 for businesses.
