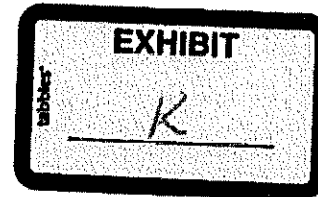

Dear Mr. Freeman:

This is to inform you officially of my decision regarding the charges of cheating and dishonest behavior which have been brought against you.

It is my judgment that you did willfully and knowingly provide false information to your clinic director in an effort to complete clinic graduation requirements. This behavior is naturally against the policies of the institution and in violation of generally accepted standards of higher education and the chiropractic profession.

I cannot impress upon you enough the seriousness of your offense. You compromised the integrity of the institution and the profession by your actions, and you displayed a contempt for those responsible for chiropractic education -- faculty and administrators -- by placing yourself above the rules and regulations formulated by those individuals. Strong and valid arguments can be made for denying you the opportunity to enter the chiropractic profession. While I am not totally convinced that you fully recognize the seriousness of your actions, I am nevertheless taking you at your word and tempering the penalty.

The College hereby suspends you for a period of one full quarter and requires that you re-enroll for Spring term of 1987 and complete all clinic requirements which have been determined fraudulent and/or suspect. Successful completion will result in the issuance of your diploma. However, any future violation will result in your immediate and permanent dismissal from Western States Chiropractic College.

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You will be required to pay a tuition in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the quarter. You will not be required to retake the clinic exit examination.

Appeal of this decision may be made to the Academic Council of the College in accordance with the policies provided you.
