



SUMMER READING CAMP STUDENTS ENTERING GRADES 1-6

**Liberty Common Summer Reading Program:
Don't lose ground this summer in reading!**

Research at Liberty Common School has shown that a whole summer without regular reading practice can cause a HUGE drop in reading level and fluency. This program is designed for students who need extra reading support and will help them maintain the progress that they have made in reading so far. Teachers will be instructing in reading, writing, vocabulary, and grammar utilizing a variety of programs including: Lindamood Reading Systems, Read Naturally, Open Court, Teaching Writing: Structure and Style, and various short stories and/or novels.

- **The cost is \$150 per student.** (*which equates to only \$5.00 per hour*).
- **Each session will be limited to 12 students***. (*register early for a spot in your grade level*).
- **All sessions will be held at the elementary school campus.** (*1725 Sharp Point Drive*).
