PROBLEM

There are not enough trained professionals to adequately assess, make recommendations, and perform design and modification changes needed to allow for individuals to live independently and with dignity for as long as they desire in their homes.

SOLUTION

The solution is to provide specialized training to professionals in medical, home design, construction, real estate, home inspection, as well as care providers, product and all related industries, about home accessibility and safety. These groups have been identified as having the greatest potential impact on quality of life at home through improved accessibility and safety.
