### **What is Speedway Indoor Karting?**

Speedway Indoor Karting (SIK) is a 60,000 square-foot, state-of-the-art family entertainment and dining facility that will open to the public in April 2016 at 1067 Main St. in Speedway, Indiana. It will include a banked oval, a multiple-elevation, 14-turn road course and a restaurant, named *1911 Grill*, featuring American cuisine and outdoor covered seating on both levels of the restaurant.

### **Is this a government funded or privately owned investment?**

Speedway Indoor Karting is a privately owned investment by Sarah Fisher and her husband, Andy O'Gara.

### **What is the economic value of this investment?**

Speedway Indoor Karting is expected to bring 35 to 40 new jobs to Speedway, Indiana.

### **What will the karting experience offer?**

There will be a two-level, 14-turn road course that will provide window views from Main Street, where pedestrians can see the speed, excitement and quality of the facility. The second track will be a banked oval. Sunken into the floor, it will be visible for spectators on both the first and second levels of the facility. Both tracks will operate simultaneously and independently of each other, allowing availability to more than one private or public function at a time.

The facility will exceed federal and state ventilation guidelines. A racing team performs on cleanliness, and Speedway Indoor Karting will operate in the same fashion. The karts will be first-class, provided from Sodikart, the largest and No. 1 supplier in the world. There will be karts for all skill and age levels. A competitive league for junior karters will provide an ideal, affordable introduction into motorsports for aspiring racers.

### **What are the details of the restaurant?**

*1911 Grill* will be a restaurant inside Speedway Indoor Karting that is open to all ages, also including bar areas for guests 21 and older. The venue will have a contemporary, casual environment with a menu that will contain traditional American cuisine. *1911 Grill* will have an open layout comprised of two stories, 8,000-plus square feet and seating for 300 guests. Features will include bars on both levels, an entertainment area that overlooks the karting tracks, outdoor seating on the first and second levels, and multiple fireplaces.

*1911 Grill* will fulfill multiple catering and banquet opportunities for larger parties and corporate clients, though this will be a secondary focus of the restaurant. *1911 Grill* will establish itself as a completely separate entity and will be open every day for everyone, including those who are not participating in karting at the facility. *1911 Grill* will serve to patrons at lunch, dinner and night periods. *1911 Grill* will be soundproofed, providing normal restaurant/bar atmosphere for guests not focused on karting. The concept will incorporate an interior theme consistent with the area, the dedicated history of automotive development, motorsports and most importantly the beloved Indianapolis 500. The O'Gara's are confident that *1911 Grill* will stand tall as a popular dining establishment in the revitalized business and public district on Main Street in Speedway.
