



## 2015 CNE Food Safety Training

To prevent disease and promote a healthy environment, Toronto Public Health (TPH) will be enforcing mandatory Certified Food Handlers. TPH will be checking for at least one certified food handler working in a **supervisory capacity** in each area of a food premises where food is prepared, processed, served, packaged or stored. Supervisory staff of food businesses must possess on them a valid Food Handler Certificate from an approved source.

An approved source is:

- (1) The city of Toronto Public Health Unit.
- (2) A Canadian Public Health Unit.
- (3) An approved organization by the Province of Ontario.

As in years past, all other staff that do not possess a valid Food Handler Certificate from an approved source must attend, in full, the CNE Food Handlers Presentation. Dates will be confirmed and sent out at a later time.

All staff handling food at the CNE are required to obtain a 2015 CNE Food Handler card and button. Non supervisory staff (employees) can obtain a 2015 CNE Food Handler card and button by either attending, in full, one of the Food Handler Presentations or, providing one of the following at a Food Handler Presentation registration:

- (1) valid Food Handlers Certificate obtained by one of the three approved sources,
- (2) 2014 CNE Food Handlers Presentation card, or a
- (3) 2015 Alberta Food Handler Presentation card
