May's First Saturday Mission event is an opportunity to help pack meals for FMSC, followed by a BBQ and fellowship at TLO. Feed My Starving Children is a Christian non-profit organization committed to feeding God's children. The approach is simple, fun and fulfilling: children and adults hand-pack meals specifically formulated for malnourished children, and then the food is shipped through distribution partners. FMSC meals have reached nearly 70 countries around the world.

Everyone age 5 and older is welcome but the ratio of adults to children will need to be managed:

Age 5 to grade 2—1 adult per 1 student

Grades 3-6—1 adult per 3 students

Grades 7-9 grade—1 adult per 4 students

Grades 10-12 grade—1 adult per 5 students (Mrs. Traeger will sign volunteer hours forms if presented.)
