<b>Purpose/Impact Statement</b>	The Summer Kick-Off Literacy Party will be the first ever Literacy Event at Barros Circle. FACETS summer programs for kids K-12 focus heavily on making sure our kids do not fall behind in reading over the summer when they are not in school. Low-income children are at a high risk for falling behind their more fortunate classmates in reading skills simply because they don't have the financial resources to have books in their household. We decided that having an event where the kids can pick out several books for free right as school is ending and summer is beginning will send a strong message to our kids and our community that reading is important, even during the summer!
<b>Activities during event</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>4pm</u></li> <li>• Volunteers arrive to help set-up, make hot dogs, set up food, organize and display books for kids to pick out, etc</li> <li>• <u>5pm</u></li> <li>• Doors will open at 5pm; volunteers will accompany the kids to help them pick out their books; then pick a book mark and a bag to keep their books in until they leave</li> <li>• <u>5pm-7pm</u></li> <li>• Once the kids pick out their books, they can eat</li> <li>• We will have activities – games, relay races, etc – Volunteer can help run those events – I will assign volunteers to be in charge of that before it starts</li> <li>• Moon bounce – 1 or 2 volunteers will need to be supervising moon bounce at all times</li> <li>•</li> </ul>
