

**TO BE OR NOT TO BE A 501(C)(3)
STEP - BY - STEP: STARTING A NONPROFIT**

Checklist, Forms and Sample Documents

STEP 1. Plan

Questions to Ask

- Do you really need to start your own nonprofit?
- Are there other nonprofits doing similar work? If so, who?
- Do you have a clear mission statement?
- Do you have a description of programs and/or services (goals and objectives) you plan to offer?
- How will you raise start-up funds and continued operational funds?

STEP 2. Establish a Board of Directors

Board should include

- People who believe in your mission
- People who have an area of expertise (i.e. lawyer, public relations, CPA, etc.)
- People from your target population

STEP 9. Determine Insurance Needs

- Liability
- Group Health
- Directors and Officers (for the Board of Directors and Staff Leadership)

STEP 10. Open a Bank Account

STEP 11. Establish an Accounting System. Examples include:

- Quickbooks
- Quickbooks for Nonprofits

STEP 12. Establish an operational calendar

- Board Meetings (should be at least 4x/year)
- Deadlines
- Important dates
