RECOGNITION, RESOLUTION, & RESPONSE



An instructor-led online course for caseworkers and supervisors that meets licensure requirements

OVERVIEW:

This three-hour course is offered in two 1.5-hour sessions via a virtual classroom, so caseworkers and supervisors can participate from their desks. The course provides a review and exploration of Ohio's ethical standards for counselors, social workers, and marriage and family therapists, with attention paid to resolving dilemmas and risk management.
