- Pray for the continuing aftershocks and aftermath of this disaster. Southern Baptist assessment teams are surveying the damage to find the best ways to respond.

- Pray for the government leaders, utility workers and road crews as they work to get the roads cleared and electricity restored.

- Pray for those in the medical field to have renewed strength as they work round the clock.

- Pray for the families of those who have lost loved ones to experience the love of Christ through those who know Him.

- Pray for the widows and orphans who do not have family members to help them at this time.



- Pray for Christian workers to daily be renewed in His strength as they look to the One who gave His life for them.

- Pray for the Nepali Diaspora working abroad who do not have any communication with their families in Nepal and are concerned about their care. Pray that the Church around the world would minister to them at this time.

- Pray for those coordinating disaster relief leaders as they make crucial decisions of where help is needed most.
