TENTATIVE ITINERARY July 22-30, 2016

Friday, July 22 Team travels to Germany

While you are in Germany, you will have a chance to reach and serve Syrian refugees and the dozens of other people groups currently residing in Germany. We will also engage with immigrants from across North Africa, Asia, and the Middle East. In just one week, you can spread the Gospel among unengaged people groups, provide tangible relief to refugees, establish new churches, and launch a Gospel movement that outlives your time on this Earth.

Training and daily schedule:

Morning: a time of training, learning how to share your personal testimony and the Gospel
 Afternoon – evenings: going out in small groups to share God's story with immigrants at various locations in the city and through creative ministry opportunities.
 End of day: worship, debrief, prayer, fellowship

Saturday, July 30th Return to the U.S. a changed person with wonderful lifetime memories and many stories to tell that Glorify God.

Expedition Cost

\$2985* from Dallas

(*contingent upon airfare prices)

\$100 Due before **February 26th, 2016**

Non-refundable deposit with trip application

\$1285 Due before **March 25, 2016**

\$1600 Due before **May 20, 2016**

Fund raising: Most people that go on mission trips raise support. e3 provides resources, tips, and infrastructure needed to help you raise support to fund your mission trip.

Cost Includes

Leadership Training: national leaders are trained prior to the team arriving

Airfare: round trip international economy class airfare

Meals and Lodging: three daily meals and nice accommodations. (meals for travel days and personal expenses not included)

Ground Transportation: in-country transportation

Literature & outreach: Outreach supplies, evangelism tracts, discipleship material and Bibles.

Follow-up: A portion of the expedition cost is used for follow-up, leadership training and discipleship of the new believers and churches.

Extended stay: You will have an option to stay two extra days to travel within Germany or Europe. You would be responsible for the logistics and expenses but e3 will provide some ideas and schedule your return flight to return to the U.S. two days later.
