Creole World: Photographs of New Orleans and the Latin Caribbean Sphere, is both a book and an exhibit. The genesis of this project goes back to 1974, when at age 20, I set out for Latin America behind the wheel of a Datsun station wagon. New Orleans was the first and only North American stop on the tour. The purpose of the trip was to test my mettle as a photographer. My only camera, which was at my side throughout the trip, was a Leica M4. It was the camera with which I took my first serious photographs and with which I learned to be a photographer. Today I'm using the digital descendants of the M film camera—an M Monochrom and M240. I'll be discussing Creole World from the perspective of a lifelong Leica M photographer and describing what this camera system meant to this project.
