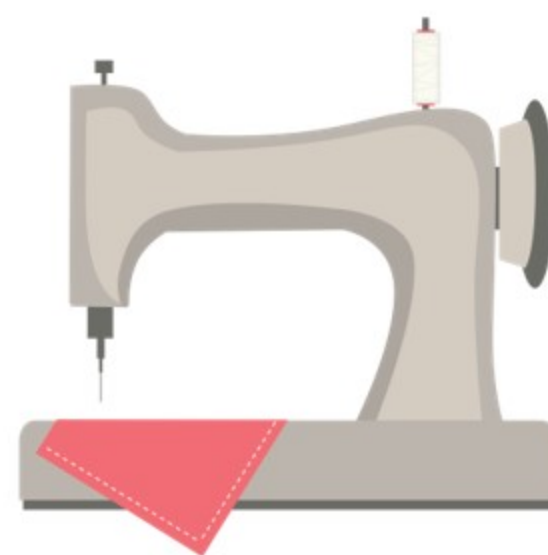

Mariela, walks usually 2 km by foot to reach the Learning Center and receive her classes. Currently, she has already made her first dress and knows how to elaborate skirts, blouses, bags and others. Mariela is a clear example of perseverance, determination, effort and willpower.

In view of all their efforts, Wisconsin / Nicaragua Partners donated Mariela a sewing machine so she can improve her financial situation.

Managua, Nicaragua. Tuesday, July 12th, 2016

My name is **Milton Jose Zelaya Lopez**, carrier of photo ID No. 001 180773 0053N and I had an accident on July 22nd, 2006.

I used to work as an independent contractor in residence electricity. In 2006, I was working on the roof of a house when accidentally I suffered electrical injuries after got contact with high tension lines, in seconds, I fell down to the ground since a four meters height.

Then, I was taken to a hospital with second and third burn injuries in 12% of my body, face, chest and feet. As results of my injuries and after several surgical interventions were practiced both my legs were amputated. Since then, I have needed a wheelchair to transport myself.

This is why I thank and appreciate the precious donation that **WISCONSIN NICARAGUA PARTNERS** granted me and **KI MOBILITY** for such valuable donation that will help me so much to be a little more independent.

My mother used to help move myself from one place to another, (due to my old wheelchair was too damaged) but unfortunately she is not strong enough since she is an old lady.
