

"...how was it that you ended up going from Nicaragua to UW-Eau Claire and then to the US Embassy in Managua?"



"Long story... I received a Fulbright program scholarship, so they sent me to UWEC... and I did not speak English at the time. You know in Eau Claire few people speak Spanish so I

had to survive and learn English in three months. After I graduated from Eau Claire in 1997, (I was there almost three years) I returned to Nicaragua, and starting working such as journalist at Channel 2. I



worked there for 6 years, become the news director of Channel 12, and 11 years ago i joined the US Embassy in the press section. I studied law, so I am also a lawyer, and I just finished my Master Degree in December. In the social area, I am helping poor kids in the country side through sports, to provide used sports equipment to kids that do not have anything." - Felix
