



**Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club**  
**2016 Doug Mills Series**  
**Notice of Race**  
**2/13, 3/5, 4/9**

**1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**

Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club (BCYC) is the organizing authority for the Doug Mills Series.

**2. RULES**

- 2.1 The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, (*RRS*), the rules of the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (PHRF), and the Notice of Race.
- 2.2 The Series is classified as a Category "A" Event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.3 Boats are subject to inspection by the appropriate fleet coordinator to ensure conformity to the applicable class rules, bylaws and/or measurement certificates.
- 2.4 *RRS* 55 is changed by adding the following sentence to the rule: "However, discarding elastic or wool bands when setting a sail is permitted."
- 2.5 US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) apply. The USSER can be found at: <http://www.ussailing.org/wp-content/uploads/2014/05/US-SER-Categories-2014-3.pdf>

**3. CLASSES**

The fleet will be divided into appropriate classes based on the PHRF Area D Random Leg Course (RLC) Ratings

**4. ELIGIBILITY**

Each entrant must have a current, valid rating issued by PHRF of Southern California.

**5. ENTRY FEE**

The entry fee is \$36.

**6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available not later than one (1) week prior to the first race at the BCYC Office, and on the BCYC website at [www.bcy.org](http://www.bcy.org).

**7. SCHEDULE AND COURSES**

- 7.1 Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 hours on the day before the race on the Race Bulletin Board at BCYC and on the BCYC website ([www.bcy.org](http://www.bcy.org)).
- 7.2 The races are scheduled to be sailed on 2/13/2016, 3/5/2016 and 4/9/2016
- 7.3 The first warning signal each day is scheduled for 1155 hours.
- 7.4 Random Leg courses will be sailed.
- 7.5 The Start/Finish line will be in the vicinity of Newport Pier.

**8. PENALTIES**

*RRS* 44.1 and *RRS* 44.2 shall apply.

**9. SCORING**

- 9.1 Scoring will be according to *RRS* A4.1 Low Point System for each day's race
- 9.2 The races will be scored using the PHRF Area D RLC Rating
- 9.3 For boats rated without a spinnaker, the races will be scored using the PHRF Area D RLC Rating plus the boat's Non-Spinnaker Offset
- 9.4 Scoring for the Series Overall will be according to the Rinderle B table.
- 9.5 There are no throw-outs. This changes *RRS* A2.
- 9.6 *RRS* A9 shall not apply.

**10. PRIZES**

- 10.1 Take Home Trophies will be given out after each day of racing.
- 10.2 Trophies for the Series will be given out after the last race.
