

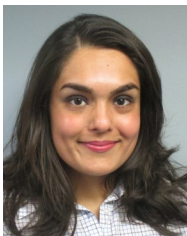
New Providers July 2016

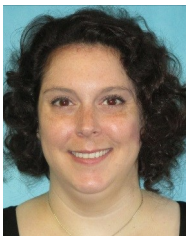

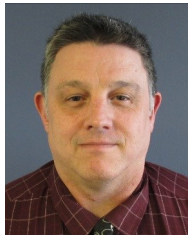
