The matter of incorporation of Tenino, coming on to be heard and it appearing that on Thursday, July 19th, 1906, an election was held of the qualified voters within the proposed territory to be incorporated in said municipal corporation, and it appearing that all the proceedings theretofore had, were proper and regular, and the Board having considered the returns of the said election finds that there were cast for incorporation within said territory, 76 votes, and against incorporation thirty-six (36) votes; and that the said election was duly and regularly held. The Board of County Commissioners of Thurston County, Washington, therefore declare said tract, to-wit, the following described property in Thurston County, Washington:

Beginning at the northeast corner of the Plat of Eureka; thence southerly 15.45 chains to a point 50 feet south of the center line of the Northern Pacific Railway right of way; thence west 3.20 chains; thence south to southern boundary of Northern Pacific Railway right of way; thence westerly 131.69 chains more or less along said southern boundary of the Northern Pacific right of way to the southern boundary of Snyder & Steven's plat of Tenino; thence west along said southern boundary to "H" Street; thence north along "H" Street to Sixth Street; thence east along Sixth Street to "F" Street; thence north along "F" Street to the northern boundary of Snyder & Stevens Plat of Tenino; thence east along said northern boundary to the northeast corner of said plat; thence south to the northwest corner of Raglass Second Addition; thence easterly on Garfield Street to Raglass Avenue; thence south on Raglass Avenue to Lincoln Avenue; thence easterly on Lincoln Avenue to place of beginning.
