AIA Architecture Week 2016 Architectural Imagery Contest

Submission Guidelines

- 1. Submissions limited to AIA members and all employees of AIA member firms. Maximum of (5) five images per person.
- 2. Images will be judged on artistic representation of the subject matter, and relation to architectural and open themes.
- 3. Images may be color or black and white and will be juried, and first place awards given in three categories:
 - 1) Open Photography (can be black & white or color)
 - 2) Renderings, Digital Media, & Sketching (architecturally themed)
 - 3) Camera Phone Photos (architecturally themed)
- 4. Format is mounted on a stiff, black background such as poster board. Total dimensions shall be 12"x 14". Actual image can be smaller and matted to fit 12"x14" frame if needed. Utilize standard aspect ratios for photography categories.
- 5. Identify on a small index card attached to the back of each submission: entrants name, employer, email, phone number and photo category.

 Also submit a brief background description about each submitted photograph, i.e. title of the photograph, where the picture was taken, your inspiration, etc.
 - Email camera phone photos to Jonathan Essa. In lieu of index card provide in email your name, company, & phone number along with the photo(s). Keep photo file format to full (actual) size. Haskell will provide complementary formatting/printing of camera phone photos only.
- 6. The typical \$10 entry fee per submitted photograph has been waived this year and is being sponsored by Haskell.
- 7. No published or copyright protected images please. Return of photo(s) will be attempted but cannot be guaranteed. <u>Submit originals only.</u>
- 8. For photography and camera photo categories <u>only</u>, computer-altered images (Photoshop-ed) are discouraged. Judges reserve the right to remove any photo from consideration.
- 9. All submissions are due to Jonathan Essa at the Haskell Building 111 Riverside Ave. Jacksonville FL, 32202 <u>no later than 5 pm, Tuesday, April 19th</u>. Entries will be exhibited at Haskell (1st floor) throughout the week of April 25th. Reception at 5:30pm on Tuesday, April 26th at the Haskell Building (winners announced at 6pm).
- 10. Winning submissions may be published. Winners will be asked to submit a digital version of their winning submission.
