

Who Is My Neighbor? (A deepening conversation about faith, race, culture, and community)

Why: A recent study by the Greater Milwaukee Foundation ranked metropolitan Milwaukee one of the most racially segregated regions in the nation – worse than Detroit or Chicago. How we understand race, culture, and individuality affects the ways we view others and ourselves, read the Bible, build our churches and engage with our neighborhoods.

What: The class will mix Bible and cultural studies, voices from faith and community leaders, along with our own small group discussions to explore the ancient question, “Who is my neighbor?”
