Crossroads Presbyterian Church's Children's Ministry partners with families in discipling children to know Christ and bring others to Him by loving one another, growing in faith, and serving others. Our core values are being joyful, Bible-centered, loving, engaging, and welcoming. Crossroads seeks a Director of Children's Ministry who has an inherent sense of call, an excitement for presenting Christ to children and their families, and a heart overflowing with joy.

Job Summary:

The Director of Children's Ministry will provide dynamic leadership to all programming for children ages birth through fifth grade. This ministry includes, but is not limited to, Wednesday night and Sunday morning programs (children's worship and Sunday school), a summer Vacation Bible School program, developmental milestones (Refer to Addendum B), and annual outreach/community events. All programs are intended to provide fun, exciting, diverse, and personal faith experiences where we focus on the truth of God's Word.

Essential Functions:

- Lead the children's ministry and direct its mission (Refer to Addendum A).
- Recruit, equip and support volunteers in children's ministry.
- Create an environment that facilitates children's growth in faith.
- Participate in the rotation for delivering the Children's Message on Sunday mornings
- Partner with parents in discipling their children.
- Oversee curriculum for theological content, scope/sequence, and continuity between children and youth ministry.
- Develop and implement operation plans, health and safety plans, and other pertinent policies and procedures.
- Coordinate needs assessments and program evaluations, implementing changes as needed.
- Maintain and communicate ministry guidelines, shepherding responsibilities, and ministry goals.
- Prepare and maintain budgets with support from the church administrator and children's ministry elder.
- Participate in weekly leadership staff meetings.
- Participate in monthly children's ministry team meetings.
- Attend weekly Sunday worship service(s).

Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Education or related field or Christian Educator Certification
- Three to five years of experience in leading a children's ministry in a large church setting.

- A strong grounding in the Christian faith, reformed theology and stories of the Bible.
- Proven leadership and management skills including the recruitment of volunteer staff, communication and organizational skills.
- Competency with MS Office, social media, smartphones, and laptops, as well as the ability to quickly learn new software/technology as needed.
- Passes a national criminal background check.
- Successful completion of pre-employment assessments.

- **Mission Ownership:** Demonstrates understanding and full support of the mission, vision, and core values of Crossroads Presbyterian Church. Can teach those core values to others. - **Spiritual Maturity**: Shows strong personal depth and spiritual grounding; demonstrates integrity by walking the talk, and by responding with constancy of purpose; is seen by others as trustworthy and authentic; nurtures a rich spiritual life; seeks the wisdom and guidance of appropriate mentors; is able to articulate a clear and consistent theology.
- Initiative: Enjoys working hard; is action oriented and energetic about worthwhile activities; not fearful of taking calculated risks; seizes opportunities; sets demanding but achievable objectives for self and others.
- Interpersonal Skills: Establishes good working relationships with all others who are relevant to the completion of work; works well with people at all levels of the congregations; builds appropriate rapport; considers the impact of his/her actions on others; uses diplomacy and tact; is approachable; avoids communication triangles.
- **Team Orientation:** Demonstrates interest, skill and success in team environments; promotes group goals ahead of personal agendas; steps up to offer self as a resource to other members of the team; understands and supports the importance of teamwork; shares credit for success with others; takes responsibility for his or her part in team failures.
- **Volunteer Management**: Provides direction, gains, commitment, facilitates change and achieves results through the efficient, creative and responsible deployment of volunteers; engages people in their areas of giftedness and passion.
