The second part of the course will take place two months later - in February 2016, at St. George's College in Jerusalem. Rodney Aist will lead the group once again on a nine day tour of the Holy Land.

This is an opportunity that doesn't come around very often, so please consider joining us for this two-part course. Come and experience these two great institutions that offer hope and room to grow in faith.
