SIEF will open for starting with Pre-K (3 and 4 years old) in September 2016.


The plan is to strengthen and grow the Pre-School program in 2017 with Grammar School enrollment commencing with Kindergarten in September 2018.

Our goal is to see the school grow into a high-school in order to prepare our students for an International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB) World School to access the best universities both In the United States and in Europe.
