

RULES

- All registrants must pay a \$20/\$35 entry fee in advance or \$25/\$40 on July 31st, which will accompany the registration form. This fee will entitle registrant to an upper section ticket (\$20) or a lower section ticket (\$35) each day of the NBC World Series Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, August 5-7. NBC Tournament Pass holders pay \$5 registration fee.
- At some time during each of the 12 games all participants will be notified to check in. Participants will have 10 minutes from that time to check in at a station located and easily identified inside the stadium. The check-in period could be at any time during the game and there could be more than one check-in per game; methods of check-in may vary.
- Participants may leave the park with their ticket stub, but will be disqualified if they do not make every check-in.

- Session tickets must be "exit scanned" before leaving the stadium. Absolutely no excuses un-less request is written and accepted.
- Participants may be disqualified for any of the following:

 a) Failure to check in within 10 minutes of the check-in
 notifier each game.
 - b) Bringing any outside food or beverage into the stadium at any time (it is against City Ordinance)
 - c) Use of profane language.
 - d) Fighting, rough play, horseplay, running or any other inappropriate behavior in the stadium.
 - e) Harassment of other fans or participants
 - f) If your wristband number and punch card number do not match or if you lose your numbered wristband or punch card.

**Any NBC employee has the authority to disqualify a participant. Participants may appeal to the Manager on Duty if they feel a mistake has been made. The appeal must be resolved prior to the next check-in period or the participant will lose the right to appeal.
