



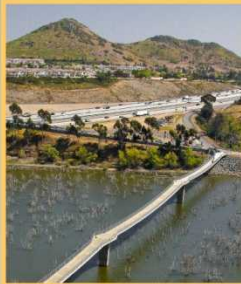

The Port of San Diego has a multitude of responsibilities over the San Diego Harbor and its associated tidelands. The Port oversees two maritime cargo terminals, two cruise ship terminals, 20 public parks, the Harbor Police Department and the leases of hundreds of tenant and sub tenant businesses around San Diego Bay. Learn more about the Port's history, their role, the things they do, and about some of their projects at our April program: Port 101.

Speakers will include **Port Chairman Bob Nelson** and **Jerine Rosato**, Sr. Manager of Government Relations.

After the program, join us for an optional guided tour of the Port's tidelands. This will include a drive along the under-construction North Embarcadero area, down Harbor Dr. past the convention center and hotels, through the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal, and then south to Chula Vista for a first-hand overview of the Bayfront Master Plan being jointly developed by the City and the Port. **There will be an additional \$16 charge per person for the optional bus tour. The Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal is a secure facility, and identification will be required.**
