History of Behavioral Consulting Services

In 2003, in response to the need for behavioral health care services for developmentally disabled individuals, the Behavioral Consulting Services (BCS) program was founded to provide behavioral health consultation to families and residential facilities in Contra Costa County. Since then, BCS has grown to provide services in multiple languages (i.e. English, Spanish, Mandarin, and Cantonese), in six counties (Contra Costa, Alameda, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, and San Joaquin Counties), and serve consumers of Regional Center of the East Bay, Golden Gate Regional Center, San Andreas Regional Center, and Valley Mountain Regional Center.

Behavioral Consulting Services

Behavioral health consultation is a problem-solving and strength-building intervention implemented within a collaborative relationship between a professional consultant with behavioral health expertise and one or more individuals with other areas of expertise. Such individuals may include parents, special education teachers, group home administrators, case managers, social workers, or day program staff. Our services utilize a multidisciplinary and multimodal approach that offers our consumers an individualized consultation experience.

In-Home Consultation

Our consultants conduct functional behavioral assessments, which evaluates the antecedents and consequences of consumers' challenging behavior and identifies functions of the behavior in order to create effective intervention plans to decrease challenging behaviors and increase adaptive skills. Follow-up services are provided to assist in the implementation of the intervention plans and maintenance of the skills learned.

Parent Training Groups

Our consultants also offer comprehensive and interactive workshops for parents on understanding challenging behaviors and behavior management strategies for their child with developmental disabilities.

Group Home and Day Program Consultation

Our consultants collaborate with group home administrators and staff to provide annual psychological evaluations and develop Individual Service Plans to address challenging behaviors, skills training objectives, and community integration goals; which improve consumers' quality of life. On-going consultation is provided to promote staff development and ensure high quality of care for consumers.

Integrated Play and Social Skills Groups

The purpose of these groups is to promote and enhance communication and social skills among children with developmental disabilities and typically-developing children through interactive play and social engagement.



Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Therapy

Our therapists utilize discrete trial training, incidental teaching, and verbal behavior approaches combining with systematic use of behavioral techniques and intervention procedures to address behavior excesses and deficits in children with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Continuing Education
