## WHITE PINE LOG GRADE SPECIFICATIONS FOR DELIVERY TO ANY HANCOCK MILL

GRADE	MIN. DIAMETER	MAX. DIAMETER	LENGTH	SPECIFICATIONS
Select	14"	none	10' - 16'	Up to 1/2" pin knots allowed 8' allowed, max. 8 per load
#1 Long	5"	none	16'	Max. knot size 1" or 3 clear faces
#1 Short	5"	none	10', 12', 14'	Max. knot size 1" or 3 clear faces
#2	8"	none	10' - 16'	Black knots to 2" or 2 clear faces Sound red knots to 4"
#3 Pallet*	8"	30"	10' - 16'	Sound red knots to 5" Black knots to 5" 8' allowed, ask buyer for details

## MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS

Trim	6" Trim. Max. length 16' 10" Min. Length 8' 6"
5" - 10" Logs	Straight with no rot or weevil damage
Stain	Fresh live wood, no stain or worm holes allowed
Sweep	Up to 1 1/2" per 8' of log before any deductions
Seams	One straight seam acceptable
Deductions	Volume deductions will be made for defects which reduce lumber volume
	No pencil rot
	8' logs, no rot or double tops
	up to 50% of diameter well centered rot allowed with deduction in logs 11" and up
	Scale deductions will be taken for knots over 5"
*3 (pallet)	Please limit #3's to no more than 15% volume per load
Preparation	Limbs trimmed flush
