Applicants must be a paid member of the William A Hough PTSA. Dues must be paid by **February 19, 2016, at 2:15pm**. Place money and [form](#) in the PTSA mailbox.

These scholarships are not renewable and a GPA of 3.0 (unweighted) or above is required to be an eligible recipient. Other eligibility requirements include:

- Applicants must have a good disciplinary record with the school.
- Financial need will not be considered.
- Students who receive a full college scholarship (tuition and room and board) are not eligible to receive PTSA scholarships.

For consideration to receive one of these awards, please submit the following information on **or before Wednesday, April 6, 2016, at 2:15pm** to Mrs. Estrada in Student Services. Below are requirement for consideration:

- Completed application form. Including signature to release transcript showing course work completed and GPA's including 1<sup>st</sup> semester grades. Mrs. Estrada will take care of verification.
- Completed essay, see application for essay question. Essays are not to exceed 500 words.
- Two letters of recommendation from faculty members, community leader (e.g. scout leader, church, coach) or employer who is not a relative.
