## GUIDELINES FOR 2015 HUSKIES POWDER PUFF FOOTBALL

- All games and practices (for players, student coaches, cheerleaders, etc.) shall be supervised by faculty members and an athletic trainer must be present at the game.
- There are written rules for the game attached to this packet. Each player and parent must review them and the PP coordinator will make sure all participants understand the game rules. Safe techniques of play will be demonstrated to the players.
- The fields for practice and games will be inspected and approved as a safe environment. The Powder Puff game will take place on the W. A. Hough football field.
- Parental Permission Form must be signed and turned in with player fee **BEFORE** any student will be allowed to practice/play. We will call and confirm with each parent.
- Practices will be scheduled by your coaches; **you MUST attend at least (3) practices to be eligible to play in the game.** Coaches will be taking attendance and it will be verified.
- Advisors and Coaches must have their final roster of eligible players to Gina Story no later than close of business on Tuesday, October 13, 2015.
- Under NO circumstances will unsportsmanlike conduct be tolerated by players, coaches or parents. The coordinator and coaches have authority to remove any student/parent from the game if they deem their behavior to be a threat to another player or to the game.
- **Coaches will do their best to allow ALL students to have some play time on the field during the actual game. We know some of you are very competitive, but REMEMBER this is not an NFL game. WE are here to support our school, each other and have FUN! No exceptions!**

## **RULES FOR PLAYERS**

- Practice may begin any time after Permission Form and player fee has been collected **ON TIME. No exceptions to this rule.**
- You must be on time to all practices. If there is a conflict with a practice date/time due to other obligations, please contact Gina Story at [jgatjstory@roadrunner.com](mailto:jgatjstory@roadrunner.com) to discuss.
- Each Player must have participated in at least (3) practices in order to play in the Powder Puff game on October 20, 2015
- Each player must wear some type of gym shoes. **NO cleats**
- Each team member will wear the same color shirt as her team members:  
Seniors: TBA                      Juniors: Black

## **RULES FOR COACHES**

- All coaches of the same team must wear the same color shirts as their players.
- Clipboards are optional. They must not be thrown.
- **NO unsportsmanlike conduct** at any time (shouting to referees or players). If so, the coach will be ejected immediately from the game.
- Coaches can be students, parents, eligible community members, Hough HS Faculty or staff. (Max: 4 coaches per team).
- Coaches are not allowed to step onto the field at any time except for player injury.
- Coaches should have some knowledge of football.
- Coaches will run all practices.
- Coaches are responsible for deciding who plays what position and when.

## **RULES FOR CHEERLEADERS AND DANCE TEAMS**

- There shall be no acrobatics or gymnastic stunts during practices or games.
- Cheerleaders are responsible for making their own “uniforms.”

## POWDER-PUFF FOOTBALL GAME RULES

1. Each player on the team must wear a flag belt.
2. Flag belts may not be tucked in, tied or otherwise restricted from coming off.
3. There shall be 11 players per team on the field at all times.
4. There must be 7 players on the line of scrimmage when the ball is snapped.
5. All players are eligible to catch a pass.
6. First downs are obtained by moving the ball 10 yards under 4 plays.
7. A player is considered down where her flag belt was pulled off by the defense, or if she falls to the ground.
8. A team has 45 seconds to run a play once the ball has been spotted.
9. All blocking has to be with arms held close to the body – **NO EXTENDED-ARM BLOCKING.**
10. A fumble is recovered by the first person to touch the ball on the ground. The ball will then be rewarded to the team who touched it on the ground at the spot of the touch.
11. Interceptions may be run back and a person “tackled” by having their flag removed.
12. All offensive players are eligible to catch a pass.
13. The offense is only allowed one player in motion at the snap of the ball and they cannot be going towards the line of scrimmage.
14. There is instant rush and you may rush as many defensive players as you desire.
15. **The ball carrier may not “stiff-arm”** a potential tackler and the ball carrier has to make an attempt to run around the tackler rather than through her.
16. Punts must be announced and no rushing the punter.
17. Punts that hit the ground are dead at the spot where the ball hit; with the offensive team receiving the ball.
18. All kickoffs occur from the 40 yard line. Any kickoff that hits the ground is dead at that spot with the offensive team receiving the ball.
19. **No jewelry of any kind is to be worn by any player.**
20. The game will consist of four 15-minute quarters with a running clock.
21. If there is a tie at the end of regulation, each team will attempt three field goals (alternating between teams) to establish the winning team. If a tie remains after three attempts, one additional attempt from each team will be made until a winner is determined.
22. There are no timeouts.
23. **SPORTSMANSHIP will be emphasized at all times for both teams and fans!**
