The MakerLab is part of the SouthWorks MakerLab Network, a network of MakerLabs across the Southland created through a partnership of Chicago Southland Economic Development Corporation, OAI, Inc., and South Metropolitan Higher Education Consortium- a consortium of 12 community colleges and universities in the region.

The Village of Park Forest in partnership with the South Suburban Mayors and Managers Association (SSMMA) won a competition sponsored by the Small Business Administration (SBA) for a \$50,000 grant from the Growth Accelerator Fund. The SBA received 832 applications for this competition nationwide, and only awarded 50 grants, two in Illinois. The goal of the Growth Accelerator Fund is to assist business accelerators with their mission to support start-ups to grow, become commercially viable, and have real and sustained economic impact.
