

# **William V Fisher Catholic School Dress Guidelines**

## **Dress Code 2016 - 2017**

Students are to arrive at school neatly groomed, in uniform, and are to remain in uniform until the end of the school day.

### **Girls**

- **Plaid Jumpers with FC IRISH** – (Grades 10-12) \*Must come within 2 inches of the knee or longer.
- **Plaid Skirts** – (Grades 9-12) Required for Grade 9 \*Must come within 2 inches of the knee or longer.
- **Pants** - Black Uniform Pants embroidered with IRISH
- **Shorts** – Black Uniform Shorts embroidered with IRISH
- **Belts** – A black solid belt with no decoration is required with uniform pants and shorts.
- **Oxford Shirts with FC IRISH** – (Grades 9-12) Long or short-sleeved in white with FC IRISH. Oxford style shirt must be worn under jumper. Shirts must be buttoned to at least the second button from the top. (Grades 10-12 may continue to wear previously purchased shirts with no embroidery.)
- **Polo Shirts** –Green or white polo shirt with FC IRISH Logo. Can be worn with skirt, pants or shorts. Must be tucked in. Available in short or long sleeve.
- **Sweaters**– Grey V-Neck Cardigan(new) or V-Neck Pullover with FC IRISH. Must wear a uniform oxford or polo under sweater. Grades 10-12 may continue to wear previously purchased green or grey sweaters with the Fisher Catholic crest.
- **Fleece Jacket** – Black full-zip(new) or half-zip fleece with FC IRISH logo. (Grades 10-12 may continue to wear previously purchased green or black fleece with Fisher crest.)
- **Tights/Knee Socks** – White, black, or gray.
- **Undergarments** – Natural or white undergarments must be worn at all times.
- **Undershirts** – Solid white only.

### **Girls**

- **Pants** - Black Uniform Pants embroidered with IRISH
- **Shorts** – Black Uniform Shorts embroidered with IRISH
- **Belts** – A black solid belt with no decoration is required with uniform pants and shorts.
- **Oxford Shirts with FC IRISH** – (Grades 9-12) Long or short-sleeved in white with FC IRISH. Oxford style shirt must be worn with IRISH tie. (Grades 10-12 may continue to wear previously purchased shirts with no embroidery.)
- **Polo Shirts** –Green or white polo shirt with FC IRISH Logo. Can be worn with skirt, pants or shorts. Must be tucked in. Available in short or long sleeve.
- **Sweaters**– Grey V-Neck Cardigan (new) or V-Neck Pullover with FC IRISH. Must wear a uniform oxford or polo under sweater. Grades 10-12 may continue to wear previously purchased green or grey sweaters with the Fisher Catholic crest.
- **Fleece Jacket** – Black full-zip(new) or half-zip fleece with FC IRISH logo. (Grades 10-12 may continue to wear previously purchased green or black fleece with Fisher crest.)
- **Socks** – White or black.
- **Undershirts** – Solid white only.

**Official Dress Uniform Attire (Mass Attire)** – All students are required to have at least one set of the official dress uniform. This will be worn on mass day, hosting guests/visitors at the school or when requested by the school administration.

#### **Girls** –

- Skirt (9<sup>th</sup> grade) or Skirt or Jumper (10-12) worn with white oxford with FC IRISH. Grades 10-12 may continue to wear previously purchased oxford shirts with no embroidery under jumper. If wearing skirt, student must have white oxford embroidered with FC IRISH.

#### **Boys** –

- Black Uniform Pants embroidered with IRISH, black belt, white oxford shirt with FC IRISH and IRISH tie. (Grades 10-12 may continue to wear previously purchased oxfords with no embroidery.)

**Please Note:** As a sign of reverence and respect, students may not wear any shorts when attending mass.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Fisher Catholic Athletic Team Jackets may be worn over the full school uniform while that team is in season. For example: Basketball, Swimming, and Bowling can wear jackets during winter sports.
