Class Description

The Junior Mariners class is BCYC's newest program open to children from 10-17 years of age, with some previous sailing experience recommended but not required. This course is



geared towards junior sailors who are interested in the lifestyle of a mariner beyond racing. Course curriculum will include destination sailing, dinghy sailing, navigation and orienteering, kayaking, knots and splicing, powerboat handling, STEM education and more.

Requirements

Class participants must complete and pass a swim test and own a United States Coast Guard (U.S.C.G.) approved life jacket fit for their daily use. Boat Charter Fee is included in tuition. BCYC Sailing Office MUST have a completed Medical Release Form on file by the first day of the program.
