Southwest Topeka Kiwanis Awards \$700 To Sheldon Child Development Head Start

On Nov. 12, 2015, the Southwest Topeka Kiwanis Club awarded Sheldon Child Development Head Start a check for \$700.

The funds were from a pancake fundraiser held in October at Lowman United Methodist Church that included a silent auction that offered several gift certificates from local businesses in the Topeka area. This fundraiser was done in partnership with Sheldon Child Development Head Start, which is a public school in the Topeka Public Schools 501 District and serves 303 children ages from three to five. As a Head Start program they provide a model of services that is designed to meet the whole child's needs. Services include: on-site medical, nutrition, family advocacy, home visitation, mental health, disability and education services.
