Key Leader Camp is a three-day event where students make new friends, learn communication and leadership skills through a series of group events, small break out groups and a ropes challenge course. Since 2005 there have been over 26,973 Key Leader Graduates at nearly 533 conferences. Graduating 8th graders through graduating seniors are eligible.
