

Long-Time Kansas Kiwanians Shared WWII Experience at Nuremburg Trial

This noon I received the sad news of the passing of Herb Whitlow (Tecumseh Club Charter Member). I noted that he was in charge of maintenance and recording at the Nuremburg Trial after WWII.

I emailed Jim Sharp sending Herb's obituary to him. Jim is a charter member of Manhattan Solar Kiwanis. Jim was Sgt. of the Guard at Nuremburg. He wrote a book about the trial titled "Sgt. of the Guard."

Herb and Jim knew each other at Nuremburg in 1945, and Jim used quotations from him in his book. Jim has written two other books, one on his experiences in the Battle of the Bulge, "Diary of a Combat Infantryman," and another on the history of the black settlements and academy near Council Grove, KS. This book was titled "Black Settlers on the Kaw Indian Reservation." Herb was very active in the Tecumseh Kiwanis Club, and Jim (at 91) is very active in Manhattan Solar Kiwanis.
