Q What is Kiwanis?

A “Kiwanis is a global organization of volunteers dedicated to improving the world one child and one community at a time”.

Q What type of “community services”?

A The major emphasis of Kiwanis International and the Topeka Kiwanis Club is serving the children of the world. The Club supports “Eliminate MNT” (elimination of Maternal Neonatal Tetanus) and many local youth programs in a variety of ways, including; Make a Splash with YMCA, Youth Baseball teams, YWCA Girls on the Run Program, Boy Scouts, Topeka Youth Court, Apple Festival, Salvation Army, Topeka Rescue Mission, Topeka Youth Chorale, Kiwanis Circle K (Washburn University), Topeka High Madrigals, Kiwanis Key Club (Seaman HS), BUG Program (Bringing Up Grades at Meadows Elementary School), Key Leader (Youth Leadership Training Program), College Scholarships for local High School Seniors, Topeka Kiwanis Foundation, Trash Mountain Project, and the Highland Park Uniform Fund.

Q Does Kiwanis support any worldwide service projects?

A Yes, Kiwanis International has taken on the Elimination Project – to eliminate MNT (Maternal Neonatal Tetanus) and work again with UNICEF to prevent the spread of tetanus to new mothers and their infants which results in painful death. Previous, Kiwanis worked with UNICEF to eliminate Iodine Deficiency Disorder, (IDD) worldwide. Kiwanis raised over \$100 million dollars worldwide to defeat IDD which was the leading preventable cause of mental retardation.

Q Where does my entry fee go?

A The entry fee which you pay to Kiwanis for playing in the tournament is handled as follows: Part of the entry fee goes for greens, carts, and driving range fees which Kiwanis pays to the Lake Shawnee Golf Course. The remaining part of your fee is divided between (1) the tournament players in the form of cash for the winning team players on the first three teams in each flight and (2) Kiwanis service programs listed above based on requests for assistance with the emphasis on youth programs. A portion of your fees along with our hole sponsorship money is put in our Kiwanis charities budget fund for our club to use to disperse to needy children’s programs.

Q What are the “SPECIAL EVENTS” for which prizes are awarded?

A Thanks to the generosity and support of numerous businesses, individual prizes will be awarded for each hole and team prizes of cash/other prizes will be awarded to the top 3 teams in each flight. Some include “Longest Putt”, “Longest Drive”, “Closest to the Pin on 2nd Shot”, and “Closest to the Pin” (on tee shots from the par 3’s). Kiwanis has sponsored a “prize on every hole” for the past several years. Last year there were additional “Hole-in-One” prizes offered on all five of the par 3 holes.
