Students are to arrive:

7:30 a.m. sharp for the morning administration

11:30a.m. sharp for the afternoon administration

- AP Students are excused from regular classes on testing day, but must contact all teachers *in advance* regarding the due date of missed work.
- Students cannot be dismissed until the exam has officially ended per College Board.
- We must have written permission from parents on file if your AP student wishes to sign out after the test. The permission slip will be sent home with your student after Easter Break. Parental permission by telephone will not be accepted during AP Exam Weeks.
- For AP students choosing to stay on campus, attendance in all classes left in the school day is mandatory.
- Dress Code on test day: Spirit shirt, regular uniform bottom, uniform shoes.

Students are to report to their respective testing rooms where attendance will be taken.

- Students who are late will not be admitted to the exam.
- Please review the College Board's Bulletin for Students and Parents that your student received.

If you have any additional questions or concerns, feel free to email Mrs. Campbell or your student's AP teacher.

You **should bring** the following items to the exam:

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers).
- Pens with black ink for completing exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams
- A watch (in case your room does not have a clock that you can see easily)

You **must not bring** the following to the exam:

- Cell phones, pagers, PDAs (They will be collected at the door and returned after the exam)
- Books, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes

- A calculator with the necessary capabilities.

- Tissues. Sniffing will annoy all the other test-takers!
- A sweater in case you get cold in the room.
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets)
