

Here are a few Exam Week reminders to help your students during that week.

DURING EXAM WEEK . . .

- If a student is finished with exams for the day, they may sign out.
- If the student does not have an 8:15am but one later in the day, the student may sign in late.
- If the student has an 8:15 and an 11:45 exam but no 10am exam, they must stay on campus in the gym. If that is the case, they may bring lunch with them to eat before the 11:45am exam.
Please note that there is no lunch service during Exam Week.
- Math students will need calculators with fresh or extra batteries.

Parents, please make sure that your student arrives at school on time - especially if they are student drivers.

- Exams begin promptly at 8:15am, 10:00am and 11:45am.
- *Students may not be signed in late or dismissed early for any appointments during their exam periods. Students will be dismissed only at the end of each exam period.*
- *Absences due to illness must have a doctor's note.*
- If an exam is missed due to an unexcused absence, a grade of zero is issued (see Student/Parent Handbook page 19).
