Environmental Technician/Administrative Assistant

The Environmental Department is looking for applicants to fill the position of Environmental Technician/Administrative Assistant (ET/AA). The Environmental Department seeks a self-motivated individual with a strong interest in mastering the components of an environmental monitoring program and supporting the Regional Tribal Operations Committee (RTOC). The Environmental Technician will be responsible for conducting activities specified in various grant work plans under the direction of the Environmental Director or his/her designee. Activities include: attendance at all RTOC meetings, recording and transcribing RTOC minutes, assisting other staff; using and maintaining scientific equipment; analyzing and reporting on data; identifying data and program needs; working collaboratively with other organizations; and developing and presenting educational and outreach materials.
